#### City Life

We have regularly engaged youth in recent months through City Life at the Swedish American YMCA. We are also in the process of expanding this outreach to include additional programming. Additionally, we are receiving a significant grant from the Kiwanis Club of Rockford focused on creating initiatives between local youth and law enforcement. All of these plans are coming together, and the vision for City Life is huge. We invite your participation as this means increasing needs for volunteers and meal teams.

### Campus Life



We launched Campus Life in the Harlem School District amidst the past year's challenges. Connections with youth and the school have formed. Plus, we even have an off-site location that has served as an oasis for youth. The vision for the upcoming school year includes many activities inside and outside the school that extend hope to Harlem students. We are also evaluating the presence of Campus Life in connection with other schools in the Stateline area.



### Juvenile Justice Ministry

Our Next Steps group continues to meet regularly, and our team is consistently involved in mentoring appointments with vulnerable youth through this ministry. We are also tapping into new connections with correctional facilities, resulting in opportunities to sow seed among other youth. The needs are vast in the juvenile justice system, and we are committed to serving this population through creative and redemptive efforts.

### Camp

Camping experiences are highly fruitful in the lives of youth (as well as leaders). We are planning a camp experience for our youth in early August. We are also looking forward to planning additional retreats throughout the year that create unique shared experiences for our youth.
