


A national crisis.

This is what the U.S. Surgeon General declared regarding youth mental health. <sup>1</sup>

A New York Times article noted, "Three decades ago, the gravest public health threats to teenagers in the United States came from binge drinking, drunken driving, teenage pregnancy and smoking. These have since fallen sharply, replaced by a new public health concern: soaring rates of mental health disorders." <sup>2</sup>


Geared to the times. Anchored to the Rock.
