It's a joy to hear the myriad of reflections that everyone shares. I always look forward to our "Gas 'Em Up" sessions as it's a lively time of encouragement filled with a range of emotions, from laughter to tears.

I've also learned that we need to keep our tanks full amidst the increasing opportunities and needs. In the last 12 months, we celebrate a rich season of growing ministry activities and connections with local youth.

CAMPUS LIFE

Our Campus Life Center has become an oasis for youth in the Harlem School District, and our community of leaders there has created a healthy, consistent space for youth to find belonging, love, and the gospel.

CITY LIFE

Our City Life ministry has embraced a faithful presence across the city of Rockford through engagement in local schools as well as a variety of weekly programs, including Club, K-PLAY, True North, and Project Foundation.

JUVENILE JUSTICE

Our Juvenile Justice Ministry models the faithfulness of Christ to justice-involved youth during pivotal moments of their lives, and we're excited by increasing opportunities to serve this population more effectively.

CAMP

We also took approximately 75 youth to camp in June, and while we encountered challenges, we praise God for the transformation that took place as youth responded to God's stirring in their hearts.

While our team is encouraged by the continued open doors for fruitful ministry, we're also overwhelmed by the increasing needs. Sometimes we need strength to keep going. We need more gas in the tank.

We've had vulnerable staff meetings, with team members groaning the outlook of our youth context or specific youth's struggles in general. We're experiencing a sense of "weakness," yet this is where we're reminded of the words of Paul in 2 Corinthians, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness... For when I am weak, then I am strong."

We've learned that we can't do this alone. We need the strength of the Lord. He is the One who truly keeps our tanks filled through his steadfast love, and He sometimes demonstrates that through a community of believers encouraging and supporting one another.

This is where we need you more than ever. We urgently ask for your commitment to prayer, commitment to serving alongside us, and commitment to investing generously in the mission of Youth for Christ. Will you invest more than ever?

The results of this work are wide-ranging: youth in tears opening up about the death of their father, youth confessing mistakes from their past, youth searching for truth amidst so much confusion, youth expressing anger over brokenness all around them, youth curious about the Bible and what it means, and ultimately youth encountering the good news of the gospel and one true hope for all of us.

Pour some gas in our tank and help us keep going. All for His glory.
